

Seasonal Parks & Maintenance Worker

Requirements

- Performs all duties under the close supervision of the Public Works Director or their designee.
- Maintain a valid Oregon Driver's License
- Graduation from high school or GED equivalent
- Follow written and oral instructions and establish effective working relationships
- Working knowledge of equipment, materials, and supplies used in building and grounds maintenance; working knowledge of equipment and supplies used to do minor repairs; some knowledge of first aid and applicable safety precautions
- Experience with mowers, line trimmer, general landscaping and maintenance helpful.
- Ability to work independently and to complete daily activities according to work schedule

Job Duties

- Perform a variety of skilled and unskilled tasks in the care and maintenance of City buildings and Parks
- Perform minor semi-skilled interior building maintenance and repairs such as painting (sidewalk and street), floor covering, plumbing, carpentry, mechanical, and other unskilled and semi-skilled trade work
- Mow and edge lawn areas using power and hand tools, prunes and trims hedges, bushes, and other shrubberies.
- Maintain current skills and knowledge in the proper and safe techniques of building and parks maintenance
- Keep and maintain records of work completed
- All other job duties as assigned

Schedule

- Temporary Seasonal, 30-40 hours/week, approximately July 1 – Sept. 30.

Rate of Pay

- \$15.00 per hour
