

WEEDS AND TALL GRASS


When weeds are present or grass is in excess of 12 inches high, a nuisance violation has occurred. The Reedsport Municipal Code defines this violation as “obnoxious vegetation”.

City staff does their best to address these violations. Citizens are asked to assist by notifying the City if they see a property with obnoxious vegetation. Citizen Concern forms are available at City Hall or you can call 541-271-3603 to issue a complaint. Once a complaint has been made, staff will investigate the complaint to ensure non-compliance. If it's determined that a violation has occurred, the City will notify the property owner informing them that they must abate the nuisance within ten (10) days.

City staff attempts to resolve complaints in a timely manner and with voluntary compliance of the property owner. Some complaints may appear to have gone unaddressed, but the truth is that, on average, 25% of complaints are regarding property undergoing foreclosure. This creates a difficult and timely process of determining the lender, communicating with the appropriate personnel at those financial institutes and attempting to get them to resolve the situation. Frequently these properties remain in a “limbo” status for several months where nobody claims responsibility for the property. This has been an issue statewide and the Oregon Legislature is attempting to pass HB 2662 to speed up the process.

FATS, OILS, AND GREASE, OH MY!

The City of Reedsport is seeking your help in reducing the fats and greases being dumped down the drain. By now most everyone knows that FATS, OILS, and GREASES are harmful to plumbing; however, every year City crews get called out because of grease blockages in City sewer pipes and waste water pumping stations. These contaminants are not only harmful to both public and private sewer systems, but also to the environment. You can easily help yourself, your neighborhood and the City by observing some easy to follow instructions:



1. Pour greases into cans or other receptacles and dispose of them in the trash.
2. Never pour grease down sinks or toilets.
3. Scrape grease and food scraps into the trash.
4. Use basket strainers in sinks to catch food scraps, then empty strainers into the trash.
5. Using some de-greasing products may simply pass the grease down the line, where it reconstitutes and causes problems elsewhere.
6. Remember that home garbage disposals DO NOT protect your plumbing system from grease.

Businesses that generate or use fats and oils need to have grease traps or interceptors installed and maintained.

Following these simple instructions will help the City minimize expenses and protect your home or business from costly repairs.

DON'T FORGET TO PICK UP YOUR ANNUAL BOAT LAUNCH PARKING PASS!

The cost is \$20.00 for unlimited parking through DEC 31, 2013. Annual passes are available at Reedsport City Hall.

Day passes are also available at the boat launches. The cost is \$2.00 per day.

In the Reedsport City Council Chambers



IMPORTANT NOTICE TO HOMEOWNERS

The City has been inundated by questions from Reedsport residents who received letters from a business called HomeServe USA. The company states that they will provide "exterior water service line" insurance for home owners.

The most common questions from residents are;

1. WHY doesn't the City cover the waterlines?
2. HOW do I get off the mailing list?



WHY? The City will repair all City waterlines up to the shutoff valve, located next to the street. From the valve up to the structure or dwelling is the ownership and responsibility of the property owner. If a home owner wishes to check on coverage for exterior waterlines, a call to the property owner's insurance policy provider would be the best place to start.

HOW? To be removed from HomeServe's mailing list you need to call 1-888-752-6740 go to prompt No. 3 and tell the operator you would like to be removed from their mailing list. For any other questions feel free to contact City Hall at 541-271-3603.
