WORK SESSION: Mayor Linda McCollum opened the work session at 6:00 P.M.

1. City Manager Pro Tem Deanna Schafer reviewed item B on the agenda (page 41 of the councilor's materials) concerning the intergovernmental agreement proposed by the County regarding "Flow Control." She provided additional background regarding the history of agreements between the County regarding trash service and the transfer station.

City Manager Pro Tem Deanna Schafer, stated some of the language in the contract appeared to give the County the right to charge whatever fees they wanted and that there was no end date to the agreement as it was written.

- Nick Fahey of Southern Oregon Sanitation (SOS) was available to answer questions by the Council and provided additional background on the agreements with the County.
- Mr. Fahey stated that signing the agreement would permanently forfeit the Cities ability to control SOS's rates.
- Mr. Fahey stated that it costs the County more to operate the transfer station than they charge residents.
- Mr. Fahey stated that SOS was in favor of the agreement.
